- Assist inspectors with technical or regulatory issues
- Lead the team by clearly communicating job expectations; planning, monitoring, and appraising job results; coaching, counseling employees; initiating, coordinating, and ensuring systems, policies, and procedures are effective.
- Maintains staff by recruiting, selecting, orienting, and training employees, developing personal growth opportunities.
- Build and maintain relationships with customer representatives and other stakeholders.
