- Certify that the installation, maintenance, repair and overhaul work meet performance and safety standards of transport Canada and AAR;
- Manage installation and service projects as assigned by the Supervisor;
- Compile work orders, inspections, repair and overhaul documentation in work records;
- Responsible for traceability on parts issued from stores to assigned job tasks;
- Report unserviceable maintenance equipment and tools;
- Report unsafe or unapproved work conditions and practices to department Supervisor;
- Attend training courses and Type Endorsements on multiple plane types;
- Any additional duties and projects as assigned;
- Actively participate in AAR Windsor's Safety Management System (SMS) including reporting safety hazards and incidents encountered in daily operations; understands and promotes the company safety policy
